Glup, Carignan, is made with grapes from the Maule Valley, Chile. It comes from an ancient granitic soil in a high degree of decomposition, with medium clay content. It has a deep purple color, with aromas of herbs, flowers and berries. It has a juicy mouth and a long finish.

This wine is a collaboration between two winemakers – Julio Bouchon of Chile and David Nieuwoudt of South Africa. Longaví, meaning 'snake's head', draws on the spirit and legends of two continents. The vine wreath depicted in the logo, denotes the ouroboros, an ancient African symbol representing nature's eternal cycle of renewal. The condor soaring high above the Andes represents freedom and the search for perfection. This sacred bird is believed to be man's messenger to the gods.
