



From the Cementerio estate, in the dry-farmed secano interior of the Maule Valley, planted in 1940, 1.2 hectares. Yellow-green in color, the wine's nose is very austere, with mineral notes that give a glimpse of floral and citrus notes, while the palate has a granular texture with acidity that leads to a long, persistent finish.

This wine is a collaboration between two winemakers – Julio Bouchon of Chile and David Nieuwoudt of South Africa. Longaví, meaning 'snake's head', draws on the spirit and legends of two continents. The vine wreath depicted in the logo, denotes the ourobos, an ancient African symbol representing nature's eternal cycle of renewal. The condor soaring high above the Andes represents freedom and the search for perfection. This sacred bird is believed to be man's messenger to the gods.
